



Staying connected with Christ Church during the Coronavirus

We know that many of you are already being regularly contacted by friends and family to ensure your needs are met during these strange times. However, we are unaware of those who are not being contacted, or those who would love to hear another voice at the end of a 'phone sometimes.

We would like to set up a network of people who would be willing to 'phone a few Christ Church members largely using our A to Z list (but there will be some additional people too).

The idea is that those who are willing to do this would have an allocated list of people to contact on a regular basis.

What would this mean?

- 1 The first time you contact someone you would need to ask them if they would like to be contacted regularly in this way.*
- 2 "Regularly" can obviously be a frequency agreed between the person 'phoning and the person being contacted, e.g. perhaps once a week.*
- 3 The more people who volunteer, the shorter our lists would be, but volunteers can stipulate how many people they would like to contact.*
- 4 Families where people are listed separately in the A-Z would be grouped as one contact.*
- 5 If you take part, this does not mean that you stop 'phoning those with whom you are already making contact or that you can't call someone who is not allocated to you.*

When would it start?

We are ready to begin almost straight away.
